

# AIGUILLES D'ENTREVES 3,600 M Climb for a day

This ridge offers one of the best views of the French, Swiss and Italian Alps.

Interesting ridge climb where you apply rope maneuvers. Highly recommended, both from an aesthetic and technical point of view. This climb starts from the Helbronner cable car (3,462m) in Italy.



#### **PROGRAM**

**The previous day** Appointment at 6.30 pm at the guides' office where you will meet your guide.

## Day 1 Aiguilles d'Entrèves

Departing from the Helbronner cable car in Italy, we make our way over the glacier to the Entrèves pass, which leads to the top of the aiguilles of the same name. The traverse runs from the edge of the ridge through blades and ridges to the pointed gendarme (top), difficulties of III/IV. We start the descent on the other side with a small abseil and rock cracks. An easy III ridge and a chimney lead us back to the snow slope of the climbing track. Fresh snow enhances the technical character of the climb.

The guides may have to adapt the program to the weather conditions, mountain conditions and the level of the participants.

## **2024 DATES**

Group sessions: on Sunday, all year round depending on the conditions and the opening of the cable car. Private sessions: every day all year round depending on the conditions and the opening of the cable car.

## **PARTICIPANTS AND SUPERVISION**

Max. 2 people per guide.

Guaranteed departure in group sessions from 2 subscriptions. You'll be supervised by a mountain guide.

## **TECHNICAL AND PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS**

This climb requires good preparation, it is aimed at sporty people with a first successful mountaineering experience (rock climbing experience is a plus). Endurance sports for training: cycling, running, hiking with a backpack.

You will evolve on an unmarked mountain route, you must be aware of the dangers associated with this activity (glacier crevasses, serac falls, rock falls, avalanches, very low temperatures).

We are at your disposal to answer your questions.

## **REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT**

Using the dated and signed registration form accompanied by a 30% deposit and the amount of the optional insurance. The balance must be paid 60 days before the departure date.

#### **INSURANCES**

Being covered by repatriation insurance is mandatory to participate in our activities: it must cover you in the high mountains for helicopter search and rescue.

If you do not have repatriation insurance, we can offer it at a cost of €5. We also offer optional cancellation insurance at a rate of €12 (this insurance does not take consider the sporting nature of our activities).
