



# **GLACIER HIKE 3,600 M**

From Pointe Helbronner (3,462 m) in Italy.

Glacier hike with little difference of height at the heart of Mont-Blanc massif on the high glaciers of Mer de Glace. Perfect for a first mountaineering experience.



# **PROGRAM**

The evening before Appointment at 6.30 pm at the guides' office where you will meet your guide.

Day 1 Departure from St-Gervais in the morning to get to Entrèves village (1,224 m) in Italy (near 50 minutes by car). From there you will take Pointe Helbronner cable-car (3,462 m) and then you will go for a walk into Combe Maudite. You will go to the foot of Tour Ronde. This glacial hiking at the heart of the high-altitude mountains is perfectly suitable for a first experience. Snow climb. You will come back with the cable-cars in the afternoon.

The guides could be led to change the program depending on the weather conditions, the mountains and the level of the participants.

# **2024 DATES**

Group sessions: Every Friday from June to October depending on the conditions. Private sessions: Every day from mid-June to mid-September depending on the conditions.

# PARTICIPANTS AND SUPERVISION

Max. 6 people per guide. Guaranteed departure in group sessions from 3 subscriptions. You'll be supervised by a mountain guide.

# PHYSICAL AND TECHNICAL LEVEL

The climb requires a good training and is addressed to sports people. You'll have to prepare.

You will progress on an unmarked high-altitude mountain route, you will then have to know the dangers linked to that activity (cracks, seracfalls, rockfalls, avalanches, very low temperatures).

#### **REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT**

Using the dated and signed registration form accompanied by a 30% deposit and the amount of the optional insurance. The balance must be paid 60 days before the departure date.

# **INSURANCES**

Being covered by repatriation insurance is mandatory to participate in our activities: it must cover you in the high mountains for helicopter search and rescue.

# **RENDEZVOUS**

Meeting with the guides the day before departure at the <u>office in Saint-Gervais (43 rue du Mont Blanc, 74170 Saint-Gervais)</u>, at the tourist office in the centre of the village at 6.30 pm. If you are unable to attend, please let us know, the briefing can also be done by phone.
